

#### Bio:

Dr. Gurvirender Tejay is an Associate Professor of Information Systems at the University of Colorado, Colorado Springs. His research expertise is in the field of cybersecurity management, information ethics, and digital privacy. Within cybersecurity, his work has focused on insider threat detection, security governance, policy compliance, security culture, and developing secure systems. He has secured over \$10 million in grant funds to support the education, training and development of professionals and educators in cybersecurity management.

Dr. Tejay was selected to serve as High-Level Facilitator (Ministers Track) for the United Nation's World Summit on the Information Society Forum 2020. He served as Guest Editor for Special Collection on 'Organizational Cybersecurity' for SAGE Open journal and Special Issue on Privacy for ACM's The DATA BASE for Advances in Information Systems journal, in addition to many other research capacities. He is currently serving as Editor-in-Chief for 'Organizational Cybersecurity Journal: Practice, Process and People' with Emerald Publishing. He is currently serving as the Chair of Education and Training for the IEEE Digital Privacy Initiative. In this role, he developed a course on "Digital Privacy: Principles, Regulations, and Ethics" with the support of IEEE Educational Activities and IEEE Future Directions.

Dr. Tejay received his Ph.D. in Information Systems from Virginia Commonwealth University. He also holds M.S. in Computer Science from the University of Chicago, and M.A. in Economics from the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee.

#### **Abstract:**

Dr. Tejay will present a practical framework that data professionals can use to help their companies identify and resolve current data ethics concerns.



#### Bio:

After rising quickly in the world of campaigns and elections as a grassroots organizer and digital strategist, Emilie launched Bossed Up in 2013 to help women like herself overcome burnout and advocate for the careers and lives they want.

Emilie works with leaders at Fortune 500 companies to support learning and development, diversity and inclusion, and human resource initiatives. She has been featured in media outlets including the Washington Post, CNN Money, Buzzfeed, TODAY, Vox, and more. Emilie was ranked among such luminaries as Chelsea Clinton and Janet Mock in the LEVO 100, and received WIN's Young Women of Achievement Award and the YWCA National Capital Area's 2015 Rising Star Award.

She earned her B.A. in political science at Brown and completed a Fellowship on Organizing: People, Power, & Change at the Harvard Kennedy School of Government.

Emilie is based in Denver, CO and combines her political past and personal experience with burnout to help others step into their power as the boss of their careers & lives.



#### **DMBoK Tip of the Month**



#### **DMBoK Pyramid (Aiken)**

Peter Aiken's framework uses the DMBoK functional areas to describe the situation in which many organizations find themselves. An organization can use it to define a way forward to a state where they have reliable data and processes to support strategic business goals. In trying to reach this goal, many organizations go through a similar logical progression of steps.

- Phase 1: The organization purchases an application that includes database capabilities. This means the organization has a starting point for data modeling / design, data storage, and data security (e.g., let some people in and keep others out). To get the system functioning within their environment and with their data requires work on integration and interoperability.
- Phase 2: Once they start using the application, they will find challenges with the quality of their data. But getting to higher quality data depends on reliable Metadata and consistent Data Architecture. These provide clarity on how data from different systems works together.
- Phase 3: Disciplined practices for managing Data Quality, Metadata, and architecture require Data Governance that provides structural support for

data management activities. Data Governance also enables execution of strategic initiatives, such as Document and Content Management, Reference Data Management, Master Data Management, Data Warehousing, and Business Intelligence, which fully enable the advanced practices within the golden pyramid.

• **Phase 4**: The organization leverages the benefits of well-managed data and advances its analytic capabilities.

Aiken's pyramid draws from the DAMA Wheel, but also informs it by showing the relation between the Knowledge Areas. They are not all interchangeable; they have various kinds of interdependencies. The Pyramid framework has two drivers. First, the idea of building on a foundation, using components that need to be in the right places to support each other. Second, the somewhat contradictory idea that these may be put in place in an arbitrary order.
